AT A GLANCE

Provisional Teaching Certificate Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree
- GACE Content Assessment
- Ethics for Educators 351
- Teacher Certification Program

REGISTER

Create a **MyPSC** account at gapsc.com. Answer the **Personal Affirmation Questions** and **update them annually**. *This step is crucial to providing a valid certificate.*

TRANSCRIPTS

Order official electronic transcripts and have them **delivered to:**
Mail@gapsc.com. The GaPSC will deposit these directly into your MyPSC account.

3

ASSESSMENTS

You will need to complete Ethics for Educators 351 and the Content Assessment for your teaching field. Here's how...

EDUCATOR ETHICS Log into MyPSC → Assessment tab → Option #7 → Register for Ethics for Educators 351.

CONTENT ASSESSMENT MyPSC → Assessment tab → Option #3 → Select your subject → Click "Register."

✓ *Must match your teaching field (e.g., High School Math = GACE Math 6-12)*

ENROLL IN A TEACHER CERTIFICATION PROGRAM by January of your first year.

Visit gapsc.com → Use the Georgia Approved Programs Quick Link

- Choose a GaPSC-approved program that matches your teaching subject
- Send proof of acceptance to HR.Certification@gcpsk12.org
- ✓ This makes you eligible for a contract next school year
- ✓ Claim your program in MyPSC to extend certificate validity by 2 years
